- 1. Abstracts must be submitted in English.
- 2. Word limit is **300 words** including Abstract Title and Main Text.
- 3. Abstract title must be in Title Case, e.g. Regional Osteoporosis Conference. The title should be brief and descriptive.
- 4. Author and co-author names and institutions are to be included in the abstract file. Please include family name and initials of author(s) and DO NOT include degrees or professional titles (Dr, PhD, Prof, MD, etc).
- 5. Abstracts should contain work that has not been previously published.
- 6. Written notification of acceptance / rejection and instructions for poster requirements will be given on or before **15 May 2012**.
- 7. Accepted abstracts are eligible for poster presentation after receiving full registration fee from the author. If registration fee of the presenting author is not received by **18 May 2012**, his / her paper is assumed to have been withdrawn.
